General practitioners are often the first place patients will come when experiencing allergic reactions in an attempt to identify and manage those allergies.

The Primary Certificate of Allergy Medicine will equip you with the knowledge to assess and treat different types of allergies — including allergic reactions to food — and provide emergency treatment. You will learn how to manage anaphylaxis, allergic rhinitis, and allergic conjunctivitis, and employ allergen immunotherapy (allergy desensitisation).

- Food allergies: Peanut, tree nut, seeds, seafood, cow's milk, hen's eggs
- Allergic rhinitis, allergic conjunctivitis, and desensitisation
